



# Since the inception of Interim Housing Program in 2020:


- 367 people since inception
- 69,889 nights of housing
- 76% have moved into permanent housing.

Since 2020, The RISE Center medical respite services has:

- 272 people since inception
- 23,362 nights of recuperative care
- 89% have stabilized health.


